- 5. Have students log into Schoology and review citing text evidence with chapter 2 questions—have students answer questions with 3:00 buddies
- 6. Review and make corrections to chapter 2 questions as a class
- 7. Have students log into Schoology and type a short response to literature using the ACE method with 6:00 buddies

- 8. Review and make corrections to the ACE method responses—same format as today with a new story (YouTube clip)
- 9. Review format for tomorrow's graded ACE method assessment
- 10. Add to the Interactive Notebook
 - Set up the Table of Contents—Record page 2 Main Parts of Speech and page 3 Parts of Speech
 - Have students glue lyrics on page 1
 - Listen to song https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=UNFPzUyHVOw
 - Have students work with elbow buddies to complete "What Is It?"
 - Review and make corrections
 - Color and glue parts of speech, definitions, and examples on page 2
 - Distribute the Parts of Speech practice WS—due Wednesday

- 4. Administer the parts of speech assessment— Students may use resources during the assessment
